CHECKLIST

1) Planning

- Do you really have to burn? Are there Alternatives
- Have you checked the weather forecast? If it's likely to be windy --- do not burn
- Smoke Direction --- who is likely to be affected by your smoke?
- What is the best time of day to burn?
- Do you have your permit with you?

2) Preparing

- Maintain an adequate fuel break
- Have sufficient help
- Provide enough fire fighting tools---water, shovels, etc
- Keep the burn away from other combustible materials and structures

3) Notifying:

- Neighbours---reduce complaints, false alarms
- Local Fire Dept or Fire Centre

4) Obligations:

- Attend the fire with fire fighting tools at all times while it is burning and there is a risk of the fire escaping
- Ensure the fire is extinguished before leaving
- Responsible to report the fire if it escapes

5) Consequences: if the fire escapes

- You are responsible to fight the fire**
- You may be responsible to supply additional fire fighters and equipment**
- You may be subject to other agency fire control costs**
- You may be subject to costs for damage to property and forests**
- You may be subject to fines or other penalties as set out in the Soda Creek Open Air Fire Bylaw**
