On August 10th, 2017 I was able to get Filtration System back online here in Deep Creek, and had also collected water samples and had them sent to Prince George Laboratories'.

And yesterday I finely got word that those samples came back clear. On August 15th, 2017 I put more water

samples into our own incubator and those as well came back clear, but according to First Nations Health I have to have three in a row that come back clear.

So this afternoon I've been able to collect more water samples and will be sending to labs today, plus yesterday I put another set into our own incubator and will be checking on them at 3:44pm this afternoon before the end of day.

Since we cannot address all outstanding questions and have a thorough discussion of all concerns at one meeting we will set follow up meetings focused on any outstanding questions or topics of concern.
