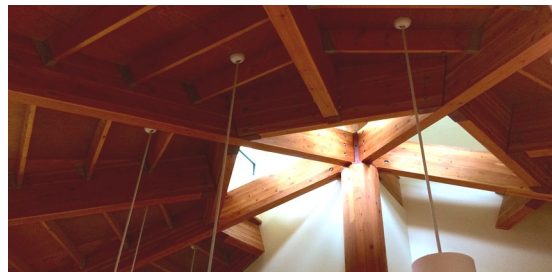

Community Activities Worker

Contributes to the overall success of the Soda Creek Indian Band by effectively developing, providing, and evaluating recreation, cultural and social programs for community members according to the Soda Creek Indian

Band's vision, objectives, and strategic direction. Manages programs for Youth, Elders and community members; develops budgets, plans and manages volunteer and support staff and prepares proposals and solicits grants as they become available.

Community Health Representative

(CHR) Contributes to improving the health and the quality of life of community members by providing services to community members requiring assistance, such as new mothers or recently released parents from medical facilities. The CHR works closely with other health care workers to provide education, case management, preventative care, grief management and other services to assist clients with their health concerns.

Community Support Counsellor

Will develop and provide prevention, education, crisis counselling, substance abuse awareness and supports, assessment, treatment, and after care service which focused on addictions, mental health, FASD, and client advocacy. Will also work with the Ministry of Children & Family Development, Youth Justice and Probation services, Soda Creek Indian Band families, youth and children, Individual or group support services and referrals to ensure the safety and well-being of families and children of the community *on and off reserve*.

Health Coordinator/Children's & Families Band Representative

Coordinates with Health Staff and partnering services to ensure the overall success of the organization and the quality of essential health services. The oversees the day to day operations, staff and volunteers, and advocates on behalf the organization / community. In addition the position include representing our members in working with the Ministry of Child and Family Development

(MCFD), Youth Probation and Corrections. Soda Creek families, youth, and children can utilize services on an individual basis or through a group support services. Our priority is to contribute to the safety and well-being of families and children of the community on/off reserve.

Health Administrative Assistant

Creates and maintains a welcoming, professional atmosphere for all visitors and clients of the Health Station. This position has a great knowledge of programs and services offered through the center. They are very effective, professional and timely in providing assistance and solutions to directing the client of visitor to the support staff for their needs.
